# Warranty

# **Limited Three-Year Warranty**

Merit Aluminum Products warrants to the original consumer purchasing these products under the provisions of the Residential Conversations Service Program, that the product is free of defects in materials, manufacture, or design for a period of three years from the day of installation.

Should the product be otherwise than warranted during this period, Merit Aluminum Products shall repair or replace the product found to be defective. "Replace" shall mean the product found to be defective, and shall mean providing free of charge an equivalent amount of new product in exchange for the product found to be defective. All labor or other costs of repair or replacement are excluded. This warranty does not apply if the product is damaged by accident, misuse or abuse. The repair or replace remedy provided for herein is the sole and exclusive remedy available to purchasers of our products: claims for consequential damages are expressly excluded.

# **Extruded Aluminum**

All aluminum products are manufactured from 6063-T6 extruded aluminum.

# **Vinyls**

Standard vinyls far exceeds the minimum standard specification in Commercial Standard CS 230-60, U.S. remains flexible down to -35°F (ASTM D-746).

# Santoprene (STP)

Monsanto Santoprene #251-80 is a thermoplastic rubber with flame retardants that have excellent resistance to compression set, ozone, ultraviolet exposure, fungus and mildew.

# Silicone

Silicone is an excellent rubber product that remains flexible at -100°F and resilient above 400°F. This material has excellent resistance to compression set, ozone, ultraviolet exposure, fungus and mildew.

# **Packaging**

Items are bulk or poly-wrapped, Individual poly wrap is a clear 2 or 4 mill poly bag that provides protection to the finish. Sills are offered with 2" or full protective tape at an additional cost.

# Fastener/ Component Parts

Most products are provided with required fasteners and holes at no extra cost. Fasteners are plated to color match the product's finish. All thresholds are punched or drilled for #10 Phillips wood screws. No. 6 Sheet Metal Screws (SMS) are provided with most door bottoms and weatherstrips. Anchors are available at an extra cost. Waterdrain thresholds include all weep holes (no extra cost).

# Stocking Policy

Merit Aluminum Products stocking policy is to keep a quantity of our various profiles based on usage. Some styles may not be stocked due to small quantity usage. Lead times on the non-stocked items will vary from 3-5 weeks.

<u>GENERAL INFORMATION:</u> All prices on Extruded Aluminum shapes include installation fasteners, screw holes, and gasket inserts as required. Special notching and fabrication can be added at an additional charge. See special fabrication charges for all fabrication options.

<u>PACKAGING</u>: For individual packaging in a clear poly bag, please indicate such on your purchase order. Specify items to be poly wrapped using the abbreviation "PW" and bulk orders to be specified using the abbreviation "BK". Any order not specified with "PW" will be shipped in bulk packaging "BK".

**TERMS:** NET 30, "CREDIT APPLICATION" must be approved prior to shipping on an open account. Please allow time for processing.

<u>DAMAGE/SHORTAGES:</u> Damages or shortages caused by the freight companies should be noted on the freight bill at the time of delivery along with pictures of the said damages. Any discrepancy should be communicated to Merit Aluminum Products immediately.

<u>RETURNS:</u> No returns will be accepted without prior approval from a Merit Aluminum Products customer service representative. A minimum 25% restocking charge will apply on all approved returns. All items must be returned freight prepaid. All special and made to order products are not returnable for credit. ALL ITEMS MUST BE IN RESTOCKABLE CONDITION.

<u>FREIGHT:</u> Orders are shipped freight prepaid FOB factory, Corona, California. Full freight prepaid on orders totaling \$1000.00 NET in the Pacific & Mountain time zones. Full freight prepaid on orders over \$2000.00 NET in the Central & Eastern time zones. Orders over \$2,000.00 NET in Alaska & Hawaii will receive a 7% freight allowance.
